

Wool Liner Recycling



WOOL LINERS

Wool Liners are a great biodegradable option for your cool-chain packaging, that is 100% composed of natural sheep wool. Thermogard's Wool Liners are encased in either a compostable film or a soft plastics film, and therefore disposal varies slightly between the two.

The wool felt, as a natural resource, is 100% biodegradable, so can be added to your garden or compost when you are needing to dispose this material. Additionally, if the Wool Liner is encased in the compostable film, the whole unit can be added to your garden or compost, as both materials will naturally biodegrade. See below for disposal instructions:

Wool Liner - Compostable Film

STRIP
Strip your wool liner of its outer film.

2



ADD
Add film and inner to your garden or compost.

With the soft plastics film encased Wool Liner, disposal is a little bit different! The wool component can still be left to compost in your home garden as normal, however the film must be stripped off the wool and recycled at a soft plastics recycling facility or bin at your nearest participating supermarket. See below for the disposal instructions:


Wool Liner - Soft Plastics Film

STRIP
Strip your wool liner of its outer film.

ADD
Add the wool inner to your garden or compost.

3



RECYCLE
Recycle the film at a soft plastics recycling depot.
